DO'S AND DON'T'S OF PRESENTING

■ DO'S

- Do practice enough so that you need only a few notes.
- Do maintain as much eye contact as possible with the audience.
- Do talk loudly enough to be heard.

■ DON'T'S

- Don't be a robot speaker.
- Don't talk too fast or too slowly.
- Don't use slang and unclear speech.
- Don't read your Power Point to the class.
